# ST AIDAN'S OSHC SCHOOL HOLIDAY INFORMATION GUIDE

#### How do I book?

- Please book in your required days using the QK Enrol app, My Family Lounge. Further details can be found on the "Booking Process" information page located on our website.
- Email/phone/verbal bookings will not be accepted.
- We are unable to accept walk-ins on the day.
- If your child has not attended St Margaret's OSHC before this School Holiday Program, My Family Lounge registration, enrolment forms and DebitSuccess form must also be completed. Your booking is not finalised until these forms have been completed.
- Additional costs for incursions/excursions apply.
   These are compulsory for all students.
- Please ensure your child is booked into the correct session. Children currently enrolled in a Kindy/Preprep program must be booked into the Kindy/Preprep sessions only. School Aged bookings are for children currently enrolled in School, Prep and above.

#### **Cancellations:**

Cancellations are only accepted up until the booking close date. Unfortunately after this point, we are unable to accept cancellations once you have placed a booking. If available, we are happy to change the date of your booking, except for Excursions or Incursions as these are paid for in advance. Changes to your current booking must be made within 48 hours of the booking date, in writing.

Excursions and incursions are set out in the program which is issued at least 3 weeks before the school holiday period. Once booked, excursions and incursions are not able to be cancelled as we have in many cases prepaid for these activities.

## **Payments:**

Payment for the School Holiday Program will be debited from your nominated bank account or credit card weekly through DebitSuccess. If you have not provided details for payment via a DebitSuccess form or your payment method has expired, your booking will not be accepted until that is received. If you have outstanding fees prior to the start of the School Holiday program, these need to be paid before your booking will be accepted.

Important: If you have outstanding fees from the term, your school holiday booking will not be accepted until these have been paid in full.

### **Child Care Subsidy (CCS):**

Our service is registered with Centrelink, Child Care Subsidy can be claimed on your fees. For further information please visit <a href="www.education.gov.au/childcare-FAQ">www.education.gov.au/childcare-FAQ</a>.

It is the families responsibility to ensure that all CRN details are correct and your enrolment has been accepted through Centrelink.

# Pick up and Drop off Routine

- All OSHC students need to be signed in and out outside the OSHC room. The iPad will be located at the doorway. An OSHC educator will collect your child from you in the mornings and bring your child to you in the afternoons.
- We ask that there is only one parent or guardian picking up or dropping off. All siblings not at OSHC will need to stay with a parent.

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# What does my child need to bring?

- St Aidan's OSHC supports healthy eating. Please support us by making healthy choices when packing your child's lunch.
- Please bring morning and afternoon tea, lunch and a refillable drink bottle. Make sure you don't bring any food that needs to be heated or cooked and remember not to bring anything containing nuts.
- Don't forget your hat, sunscreen and comfortable appropriate clothes and enclosed shoes. NO HAT MEANS NO OUTDOOR PLAY!
- At least one extra set of clothes in a plastic bag must be included in each child's bag for wet weather contingency. Please ensure they are seasonally appropriate.
- Children are encouraged to wear "play clothing" that can get dirty and be subject to wear and tear.
- Children will be asked to wear aprons when painting etc but OSHC will NOT be held responsible for damage to clothes.

# Extra-Curricular Activities

 Staff will not be escorting children to extra-curricular activities over the school holiday period.

### Late Fee

 A late fee of \$10 for the first 10 minutes or part thereof, and \$1 per minute thereafter will apply if your child is collected after the closing time of the centre. Please note this is charged per child. We understand that delays may occur, however we are only licensed to operate until 6pm.

# **Use of technology**

- Children are welcome to bring electronic devices including iPods, iPads, Kindles etc, but OSHC will NOT be held responsible if these are misplaced or broken.
- The device will also not be connected to the schools WIFI.
- Please ensure your child also brings a pair of headsets.
- Students will be able to use electronic devices between the hours of 12:30pm and 1:30pm and 4pm-6pm only.
   Please discuss this with your child before they arrive.

## Illness and Infectious diseases

- St Aidan's OSHC aims to promote the health and safety
  of all children by providing a safe and hygienic
  environment. To minimise the spread of "germs", it is
  essential that all ill children and staff stay at home until
  well. Anyone with an infectious disease will be required
  to stay away from the service for the recommended
  period set out by the Department of Health.
- Parents and guardians who keep their ill children home from care may be eligible for their days at OSHC to be cancelled free of charge, upon presentation of a doctor's certificate. Cancellations of all care must be made in writing to oshc@staidans.qld.edu.au as soon as the decision has been made not to send your child to OSHC.
